Renunciation of Indian Citizenship and Surrender Certificate for those who have acquired foreign Nationality on or after 01/06/2010.

Application for Renunciation has to be applied online in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Foreigners Division) website (<a href="https://indiancitizenshiponline.nic.in">https://indiancitizenshiponline.nic.in</a>/Renounce) The applicant has to click on "Declaration of Renunciation of Citizenship under Section 8 of the Act Made by a Citizen of India who is also a Citizen or National of another country"

The renouncer would fill all his/her details and upload relevant documents (Indian passport copy, City Registration, Nationality Certificate German passport copy in the respective folders) in above mentioned website, take a print-out and visit the CGI Frankfurt for signing the declaration before the Consular Officer.

Once the application form is submitted online by the applicant, then no further modifications are allowed. Hence applicants are requested to carefully verify the details before submitting the online Application form.

Surrender Certificate for former Indian nationals, who acquired foreign nationality before 01.06.2010):

- 1. Application has to be filled online URL https://portal3.passportindia.gov.in/Online/index.html
- 2. The last held Indian passport is to be presented at the Counter of the Consulate.
- 3. Nationality Certificate indicating exact date of acquisition of foreign nationality from the concerned authority.
- 4. Three passport size photograph (size 5.0 cm x 5.0 cm with light background showing front view of face). One of the photos is to be pasted on the application

form. The remaining photographs should be submitted intact (please DO NOT staple the photos or sign over them).

- 5. Current German passport and photocopy.
- 6. Original Indian passport and photocopy of the passport, including endorsements, if any, done by Indian Passport Issuing Authorities.
- 7. Photocopy of the Meldebescheiningung and Einburgerungsurkunde/ Nationality Certificate. Original Resident certificate to be shown at the counter.
- 8. Prescribed Fee (Euro 82) should be paid at the Consulate. Applicants should ignore online payment fee of Rs.8000/- through MHA portal.
